1 Introduction

The APS Video Player is a tool for opening and watching video TAR files that were recorded with the APS people sensors.

The current version 1.8 introduces compatibility for the APS-M firmware version 1.5, and fixes some issues.

Tool compatibility

The APS people sensor software will be continuously improved, and new features will be added. Thus the video player needs to be extended sometimes as well. However, we strive to keep the program backwards compatible to videos recorded with every older firmware version.

Installation instructions

Before installing, it is recommended to uninstall older versions of the APS Video Player.

The software will be delivered as an executable Windows installer. Download the setup program to a local drive, execute it and follow the instructions.
